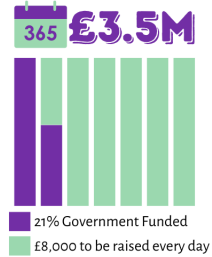

Alice House Hospice

Alice House Hospice provides care and support to people affected by life limiting illness or the death of a loved one in Hartlepool, Tees Valley and East Durham. Our services make a real difference to the lives of local patients and families throughout these communities.

We offer a wide range of Inpatient and Outpatient services to individuals who have been diagnosed with illnesses such as cancer, organ failure and neurological diseases. We support our patients and their families from diagnosis throughout their journeys.



It costs over £3.5m to fund our services for one year. We receive just less than 21% of this in Government funding, leaving a shortfall of just under £8,000 to be raised every single day. The Guild of Patrons

Our Guild of Patrons represents the highest level of formal support from businesses. To join the Guild, each member/organisation pledges a donation of £5,000 per year, which can be paid as a lump sum or in installments. This ensures guaranteed and sustainable income, which helps to deliver, plan and future-proof our services, something that is more important than ever, in these challenging times.

The members of our Guild are long-standing supporters of local Hospice care and are invited to be involved with a variety of projects (optional, of course) and are regularly contacted with news and updates regarding what is happening at Alice House.

Members are given a plaque displayed within Alice House Hospice and also receive one to display in their own business premises.

Charity Partnerships

Sponsorship

Sponsoring an event, project or fundraiser or nurse. Sponsorships are available throughout the year to suit all budgets.

Advertising opportunities are available in Hospice brochures, calendars and other publications which are circulated throughout our wide catchment area.

Volunteering

Some organisations allow staff members to use a set amount of work time such as a day or week per year to volunteer for charitable causes. This could mean working at Hospice events, within the Hospice itself, or providing valuable services.

Partnership Events
